- Bursary may have a contractual employment obligation, at the discretion of AMSOL, based on operational requirements
- Students are responsible for their own registration at a Tertiary Institution for 2025
- Basic bursary will cover tuition as a minimum. Other expenses including residence and textbooks will be awarded at the discretion of AMSOL, depending on financial and personal circumstances
